In affirming a common identity, a framework of shared values, this charter guarantees an equal quality of care for every child, all the while respecting the diversity of the structures within the Renens-Crissier network.

Placed at the center of the thought process, the child is considered as a citizen (inhabitant of the city) capable, competent and also as an individual who explores, progresses and interacts with his/her environment. To accompany them in their development, the values that aim to guide the actions of partners in pre-schooling were defined around four major axes.



The Child:

Allow the child to build trust in the adults who take care of them Consider the child as unique and important within the group Allow the child to develop social competences



The Parents-The Family:

Foster exchanges with the families that encourage an environment of trust while respecting uniqueness and diversity within the collective



The Professionals and the Teams:

In the interest of the child, foster communication amongst the teams conducive to reinforcing self-confidence and trust in others Foster solidarity and link together the various points of view and perceptions in order to define the actions necessary for the child's best development



The Place of Care-The Environment:

Create a secure and stimulating environment which promotes pleasure in learning and interacting with all who surround the child
